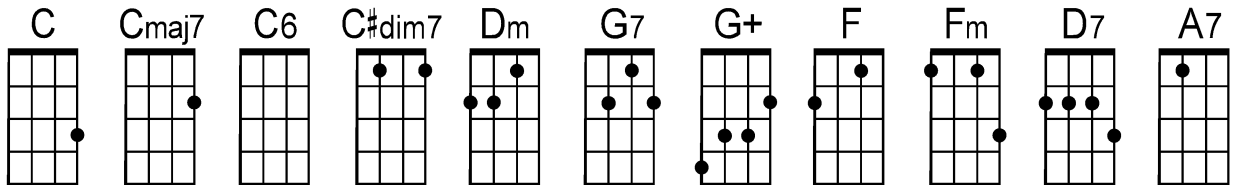


# Jingle Bell Rock

$\begin{array}{cccccccccccc} C & & C_{maj7} & & C_6 & C_{maj7} & C_6 & C & & C_{\#dim7} & Dm & G7 \\ \text{Jingle bell, jingle bell, jin-gle bell rock, jingle bell swing and jingle bell ring,} \\ Dm & & G7 & & Dm & & G7 & Dm & & G7 & & G+ \\ \text{Snowin' and blowin' up bushels of fun, now the jingle bell hop has be-gun.} \\ C & & C_{maj7} & & C_6 & C_{maj7} & C_6 & C & & C_{\#dim7} & Dm & G7 \\ \text{Jingle bell, jingle bell, jin-gle bell rock, jingle bells chime in jingle bell time} \\ Dm & & G7 & & Dm & & G7 & Dm & & G7 & C & C7 \\ \text{Dancin' and prancin' in jingle bell square, in the frosty air.} \end{array}$

**Chorus:**  $\begin{array}{ccccccc} & F & & Fm & & C & \\ \text{What a bright time, it's the right time, to rock the night away.} \\ & D7 & & G7 & & Dm & G7 & G+ \\ \text{Jingle bell time is a swell time,... to go glidin' in a one-horse sleigh} \end{array}$

$\begin{array}{cccccccc} C & & C_{maj7} & & C_6 & C_{maj7} & C_6 & C & & A7 \\ \text{Giddy-up, jingle-horse, pick up your feet, jingle around the clock} \\ F & & & & Fm & & D7 & & & \\ \text{Mix and a-mingle in a jinglin' beat,} \\ & G7 & D7 & & G7 & D7 & & G7 & C & C7 \\ \text{That's the jingle bell, that's the jingle bell, that's the jingle bell rock!} \end{array}$
