NOTES: 1. PICKING: thumb pick the strings 3rd, 2nd, 1st, 2nd and hammer-on the note of the 1st string; 2. STRUM: straight shuffle '1-and-2-and-3-and-4-and' with thumb (down) and forefinger (up); 3. SINGING: All sing the BRIDGE; in VERSES underlined bits are sung by all; 4. MANDOLIN 'CHOP' is a downbeat with your thumb on the side of the fretboard, muting the strings with your palm, then a vigorous up-strum with your forefinger on the "ands" between the beats.
