VERSE strumming is spare. After the initial C, just strum on the "and 1" beats.

So: "1 . . . and 1 . . . and 1 etc." You can emphasise the G7 – C by down-strumming only on the first beat of each bar. In the BRIDGES use a 'Church lick': D . DUDUDU.
